


HOW TO USE THIS PRODUCT:


THIS ACTIVITY IS DESIGNED TO ALLOW FOR STUDENTS TO CONNECT WITH EACH OTHER IN A SIMILAR WAY TO TRADITIONAL CENTERS WHILE STATING SAFE BY MAINTAINING SOCIAL INSTANCING. "THIS PARTNER ACTIVITY ALSO ALLOWS FOR INTERACTIONS WITHOUT THE NEED TO SHARE MATERIALS. WHILE IT IS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING, THE HATURE OF SINDER CENTERS ALSO MAKES FOR A GREAT GRAB AND GO ACTIVITY THAT CAN BE COMPLETED ANYWHERE: IN THE CLASSROOM, IN THE HALLWAY FOR INTERVENTION PRACTICE, EVEN OUTBOORS ON A SUBMY DAY

CENTER CARD SET-UP:


- PRINT THE PAGES NEEDED FOR EACH STUDENT AND PLACE THEM IN CLEAR PAGE PROTECTORS. (I TYPICALLY PRINT THE "READER" PAGE AND CORRESPONDING "RESPONDER" PAGE BACK-TO-BACK NOT ONLY TO SEVE PAPER, BUT TO ALLOW FOR STUDENTS TO EASILY FLIP BACK AND FORTH BETWEEN THE TWO AS THEIR ROLE CHANGES DURING THE ACTIVITY. A SECOND OPTION WOULD BE TO PRINT THE READER AND RESPONDER CARDS BACK-TO-BACK AND THEN LAMINATE THEM (AGAIN SO THAT THE STUDENTS COULD USE DRY ERASE MARKERS WHEN COMPLETING THE ACTIVITY AND SO THAT THE CARDS CAN BE REUSED).
- NEXT, DECIDE HOW YOU WOULD LIKE STUDENTS TO ACCESS THEIR CENTER MATERIALS. THERE ARE MANY WAYS THIS CAN BE DONE, HOWEVER HERE ARE TWO EXAMPLES IF YOU ARE LOOKING FOR IDEAS.
 - BINDER: PLACE THE PAGE IN THE STUDENT'S INDIVIDUAL BINDER TO BE PULLED OUT AND CARRIED TO THEIR CENTER SPACE. THIS CAN BE STORED IN THE STUDENT'S DESK, ON A SHELF, A STUDENT BIN, ETC.
 - CLIPBOARD: CLIP THE PAGE BEING USED ONTO THE STUDENT'S PERSONAL CLIPBOARD. THIS ALLOWS FOR THEM TO EASILY CARRY THE ACTIVITY TO THEIR CENTER SPOT AND WILL ELIMINATE THE TIME IT COULD TAKE TO FLIP TO THE APPROPRIATE PAGE.

"NOTE: FOR THIS ACTIVITY THE STUDENTS WILL ALSO NEED A DRY ERASE MARKER AND SOMETHING TO USE TO WIPE OFF THE PAGES WHEN COMPLETE. BOTH ITEMS COULD BE STORED IN A PENCIL POUCH RIGHT INSIDE THEIR BINDER FOR CENTERS OR IN A PERSONAL STUDENT MANIPULATIVE BOX/CONTAINER. IN ADDITION, THE STUDENT DIRECTION CARDS CAN BE EITHER POSTED ON THE WALL NEAR THE CENTER AREA, OR A COPY CAN BE PROVIDED TO EACH STUDENT WITHIN THEIR BINDER. THESE MAKE






